
WHEREAS, on or about May 28, 2024, the Division of Election Law Enforcement of the New York Board of Elections (DELE) received a complaint alleging that Michael Geraci, Candidate Filer Id – 36652, currently running for city court judge in Rochester, and committee Filer Id – 415142 Committee to Elect Michael Geraci held fundraisers prior to being registered with the New York State Board of Elections (NYSBOE); and

WHEREAS, New York State Election Law §14-102 states that if a candidate or an authorized political committee is raising or spending money in support of their campaign, they are required to register with NYSBOE and file the required campaign financial disclosure statements; and

WHEREAS, DELE staff found that Candidate Geraci and the Committee to Elect Michael Geraco had registered with the NYSBOE on May 28, 2024. The DELE contacted the committee, requesting clarification of campaign monies received or expended prior to registration with NYSBOE. On September 24, 2024, the committee filed an amended 2024 32-Day Pre-Primary Report to account for those monies; and

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing, this matter is closed with no further enforcement action.
